

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GIVE HOPE A RIDE BUYER AGREEMENT AND RULES</b></p>
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Upon registering, the bidder (“Buyer”) agrees to adhere to the following terms and conditions as well as all terms and conditions printed on auction lists, announced at the live auction, posted with the online auction, and announced in advertisements on the Casa Esperanza (“The Agency”) website. The Agency reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time without providing prior notice to the Buyer.

### **Registration**

1. All bidders must register online at <https://casanm.org/ghar/bidder> or by contacting the Give Hope a Ride office at (505) 266-4427 during normal business hours. No one under the age of 18 may be registered or admitted into the auction lot. Each Buyer must present a valid driver’s license upon registration and the bidder must be in good standing to register.
2. Registration is not required to preview vehicles
3. After verification the bidder will be provided a link to the auction website where they will complete the auction registration.
4. Bidders must be registered individually. Bidders are not allowed to bid on behalf of another individual.
5. Upon registration, bidders will be able to view the vehicles in the auction. Questions should be directed to the Give Hope a Ride office.
6. Bidder Registration closes at 4 pm on the first day of the auction.

### **Preview**

1. Access to the vehicle lot requires face coverings and adherence to social distancing standards.
2. No one under the age of 18 will be allowed on the car lot.
3. To reduce theft and destruction of vehicles, any person caught removing items from vehicles or attempting render them inoperable, including but not limited to such activities as cutting or tampering with wires, removing keys, parts or fuses will be asked to leave the property and barred from attending any future auction.
4. Preview days will be held on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday the week of the auction.
5. Vehicles may be started but cannot be test driven.

### **Auction**

1. Information provided by the Buyer will be used to prepare the title. We will not put the vehicle in any other person’s name other than a registered bidder.
2. The auction will begin on Friday and remain open until Sunday at 8:00 pm MST.
3. Bidding will be done online through the website or the app.
4. Notifications will be automatically generated when bids are outbid, the bid is the highest and when the vehicle is won.
5. Some online bids must meet a reserve for that vehicle for the bid to be accepted.
6. The Agency reserves the right to withdraw any vehicle from the auction, at any time, for any reason, at its own discretion.
7. Consignment Vehicles will not be released to Buyers until the owner accepts their bid. The Buyer will be contacted the day of the auction if the bid has been accepted. All rules apply to consignment vehicles after Buyer is notified. (We currently do not accept consignment vehicles)
8. If a Buyer reneges on a vehicle, the Buyer agrees to pay a \$500.00 Renege Fee and will not be permitted to bid in future auctions until this fee is paid.
9. A Buyer’s Premium (10% fee) will be included to the final price of each item sold. It is the Buyer’s responsibility to take this fee into account upon bidding.

10. Dispute resolution is at the sole and absolute discretion of the Agency and it reserves the right to reject or void bids at any time, for any reason.
11. Payment can be made with cash or credit cards. American Express is not accepted.
12. Violation of these rules will result in banning of the bidder from future auctions.

### **Post-Auction**

1. Winning bids will be available for payment and pick-up beginning on Monday at 12 noon following the auction and all vehicles must be paid for by Tuesday at 4 pm following the auction.
2. All paperwork and title transfers will be completed at the time of payment.
3. All purchased vehicles must be removed from the lot before 4:00 pm of the Wednesday following the auction or a storage fee of \$10.00 per day will be charged.
4. After ten (10) business days following the aforementioned final pick-up day, any vehicle(s) belonging to the Buyer and monies paid by the Buyer will be forfeited.
5. No vehicles may be removed from the premises until the end of the auction.
6. New Mexico State law requires the completion of title and registration processes for a new vehicle within thirty (30) days of purchase. It is the Buyer's responsibility to satisfy these requirements before sale or transfer to a new buyer.
